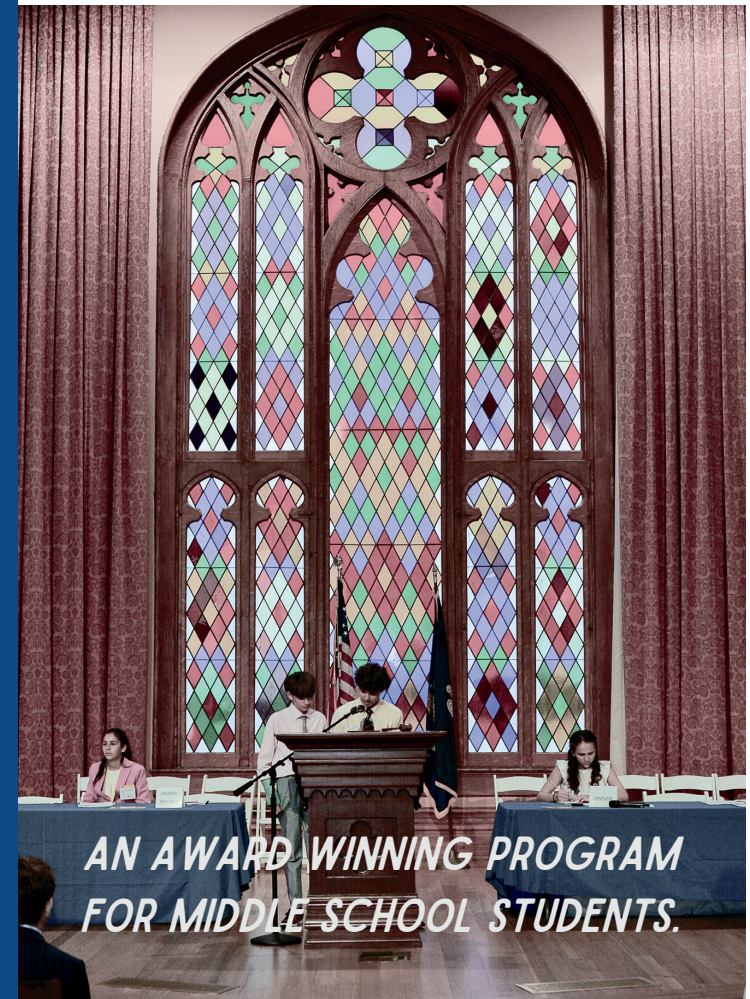

The Youth Legislature program began in 1978 in Baton Rouge.

Youth Legislature is open to all middle schools and is currently serving more than thirteen parishes: Ascension, Bossier, East Baton Rouge, Iberville, Jefferson, Lafayette, Livingston, Pointe Coupee, Rapides, St. Landry, St. Martin, West Baton Rouge, and West Feliciana. Youth Legislature also serves University View Academy, a virtual statewide public school.

Eight, 2-day sessions are held annually serving forty plus schools from around the state totaling 1,800 to 2,000 students. Since 1978 Youth Legislature has served over 40,000 middle school students in the state of Louisiana.
